### Minor Days

**Season of Teshuvah (Repentance):** Rosh Chodesh Elul, the first day of the month before Tishri, traditionally marks the beginning of a 40-day season of repentance that culminates in the solemn day of Yom Kippur. This month is to prepare for the 10 days of repentance (awe).

**Link** **Rosh Hashana LaBehemot:** “New Year for Tithing Animals” During the time of the Temple, this was a day on which shepherds determined which of their mature animals were to be tithed. The day coincides with Rosh Chodesh Elul, the New Moon for the month of Elul, exactly one month before Rosh Hashanah.

**Link** **Fast of Gedalia:** "Rabbis have said that its aim is to establish that the death of the righteous is likened to the burning of the house of our God. Just as they ordained a fast upon the destruction of the Sanctuary, likewise did they ordain a fast upon the death of Gedaliah."

[Link](#) **Shabbat Shuvah "Sabbath of Return"**: Weekly Sabbath between Yom Teruah and Yom Kippur where Hosea 14:2-10 is read. Some communities add Joel 2:11–27 and/or Micah 7:18–20, and literally means "Return!" (See also Hosea 2:14-23)
